Kyle- I think the misconception here is that it is a personal facebook page. It would be strickly an NA facebook page. It would be upto the individual to affiliate or not affiliate. Rob- you can have the page set up so it is not interactive. There is no chat room and no joining the group. There is a group that I am a member of called "Decades Clean" there is no personality bashing on it and it is a celebration of recovery. Patrick- as far as the groups, they can be totally locked down and only get in by invite or joining. It is my choice to break my anonymity or not. My anonymity was brken last year by being tagged in a photo from convention13. I lost business over this, and It was a blessing, because they were a pain in the ass. There is a lot of literature available about protecting anonymity on social media. Sponsors have a huge role in guiding people with this. There are so many ways that we can protect each others anonymity. I do not see it as an issue. We are not a secret society. We have to be out there to attract the younger generation of addicts. Carla- I agree with everything that Patrick said. Our group is still talking about this and we are aware that there is

service material but we have not gone over that yet. We are just looking at options. Tommy- I feel like I am pretty old and I have been messing around on facebook for a while. I am a part of 8 different NA facebook groups, I have never had any trouble with this. I see the benefit of an NA facebook page. Monique- I feel it is beneficial also, sometimes there is a just for today posted for people who do not have books. Nobody else on face book knows unless you are a part of that group. Ben- na.org will send just for today to your email. I read it while I drive. Tommy- I think it is something to think about as a body. Shawn- if you are thinking about it, get with other addicts to find pros and cons.

## **Old Business**

1. **Guidelines-** Tommy was supposed to type up the guidelines and he said "no I didn't!" Tommy please put it in the minutes so I will remember. Bill- I was the chairperson for that committee, is that what we finalized at the last meeting? Delynda-Bill, just so you are aware, not everything that was brought was not voted on. Bill, I will have to go home and read the minutes. Shawn- Tommy will you please get that taken care of and get it to everyone. Tommy "yes."
2. **Recorder-** Shawn, have we taken it back to the areas? Tommy- our area thought it would be irresponsible to meet while we were hosting the convention, so we have not met. Ben- our area said it was fine and there would not be any problem with this as long as it stays within the region. The only real concern is anonymity. Shawn- we have 1 area that discussed it. How would we like to proceed? Ray- I am pretty sure that our area would be fine with that. Rob- I do not think it is an issue, but we have not discussed it. Mark, I think our area would be fine with it. Delynda, I think there are other questions about this recorder, how we are going to manage it and who has it, do we stream to the website or not. These are the questions to ask our areas. Steve- how are we going to do this and our anonymity and that would be my biggest concern. The fact that no one has discussed this with their areas and it is concerning to me. Bring it to the region as a motion. Sounds like a dead issue to me. Tommy- there is not any reason why this cannot be further discussed. Another couple months won't make a difference. Carla- stuff was not getting in the minutes, so this is why I brought it up. Are there any concerns are what we needed to discuss. We would need to make guidelines for this. It just makes sense to have it. Bill- my question is that Steve and Delynda think alike on the anonymity thing. Is it your concern for future people coming in to positions? Delynda- it was not my concern, it was in the minutes. If it was streamed to the website do we password protect. Bill- only people who know the password. Is the concern of the anonymity for the people in the area? Only a first name is mentioned. Do we have a concern? Shawn- that is why we wanted to take it back to the area. Patrick- anywhere there is a password, there is a chance that someone could get pissed and share the password. It all could be redacted. I may be missing the point here. If it is for an archive, then it should be kept as a digital copy on a computer and not online. Kyle- maybe there is just not the knowledge, because our password is really simple, we have the most common password. When it comes to service, I am a representative and my anonymity is slightly given up for service positions. Only the people who know us could identify our voice. Bill- make a motion to take it back to our areas and bring it back to the next meeting in October, Rob 2<sup>nd</sup>, Shawn- any discussion? Ben- didn't we do this last meeting? Patrick- I agree but I think that the

areas should read the minutes and discuss it from there and everyone be prepared when we come back, motion passes. Shawn- get it to your areas and let's make an informed decision.

3. Discussion of voting and active groups- Steve, we do not have anything saying that freedom seekers is in active? Tommy- there is nothing in our guidelines that says that you become inactive. Bill- it used to be there, it is 2 meetings. We used to set aside the guidelines to remedy this. Shawn-since we do not have our new guidelines to look at, we may have to wait till we can look at it then. Tommy- how did this come up? I have come for 9 years and more often than not Freedom Seekers has not been represented. Steve- we want to avoid them thinking we have kicked them out of the committee. We just want to show the understanding that they are just inactive and still part of the body. It is probably just a communication thing. Lets communicate this to the people we are responsible for. Carla- it came up when we were talking about the convention and where it was to fall next. Tommy- too bad we didn't record it. Shawn- where do we want to go with this? Bill- I think if it is not in the guidelines, then we as a body can add something to this. Shawn- was that a motion? Bill- motion " any area missing 2 meetings in a row without giving a proxy, are inactive members of the region and may be reinstated by attending 2 meetings in a row, and are then reactivated as voting members" Ray, 2<sup>nd</sup> Carla-where we are only meeting 3 times a year, I think that is a little far out. Tommy- I speak in opposition to the motion because our purpose is to serve an area. We are not serving the area by instituting this policy. We should do what we can to encourage them to get here. It does not speak to what our purpose it to serve. Maria- we have 6 potential members of that area, and I like what Tommy said. Steve- I see both sides of this and I think that the intent is that if they came to one meeting and then they get to vote before they know what is going on. It is a practical matter. Mark- by letting people come to a couple business meeting they can get a lot of info and make an informed decision. Coming to 2 and being able to vote at the 3<sup>rd</sup>, shows commitment., Patrick- if we have quality minutes, then they can read the minutes and speak coherently to the issues. They should be able to show p informed. Kyle- is it in the guidelines that inactive means no vote? Tommy that is why we are speaking about this. Kyle- I felt dismissed when I was here before, but I didn't feel validated. Bill- my intent is not to exclude anyone from NA, we would just like to know that an area that is coming to this body is defining themselves and getting back to unity. Who are the members of the Freedom Seekers area? What we want to know is how we can help you with your recovery. This is so we are able to conduct business. I did not make that motion to make anyone feel unwelcome. Delynda- we are putting too much stock in the vote. If you are here you are a part of the body. Just because you don't raise your hand to vote, does not mean you are not a part of. It is about coming and learning more about service, and don't get hung up on the vote. Johnny- I think that the vote part is not a big deal. I'm still going to keep an open mind and participate. Ray- in keeping it simple, I feel it is no different that a new area coming in. Carla- the biggest concern is defining what an inactive area is or is not. 7 for 2 against motion passed. Shawn- will you add that into the guidelines Tommy?
4. Checking account audit during October workshop time- Delynda- who will do this and when Tommy – it says that the executive committee would do that. Shawn- that would include everyone except for the RCMs. Patrick- is that really workshop material? Shouldn't the audit be

done as a special meeting and not take up workshop time? Steve- I motion to rescind this motion that was made at the last meeting. Tommy 2<sup>nd</sup>. Steve- this takes away from the workshop time. We are not serving our groups. Carla- isn't there a way that we could do both. I think it is a really good idea to take responsibility. Steve- I am not a committee member at this time. Delynda- you cannot bring it at this meeting. Discussion followed. Kyle- can I make a motion to amend that? Delynda- no. Steve- you need to make a new motion. Bill- it is Carlas responsibility to take the responsibility of the delegate when she can't fulfill her duties. Patrick- can a motion be made to do it before or after the workshop. Patrick motions "the auditing of the check book is moved to before the workshop at 9:00 in October. Tommy 2<sup>nd</sup> Delynda call the question 6 for 2 abstain. Passed. Mark- let's get done with old business and then we take a break. Shawn- take a 6 ½ minute break.

Patrick- the website would not be in jeopardy for any reason. Tommy-When you made the changes to the website did you know this would happen? Patrick- no Tommy if we are getting out of our contract early, can we get any money back? No. Delynda- really doesn't cost much. About 8 bucks a month. We have the Annual Area Learning Days planned for July 20 at Lyman at the Heritage Park Pavillion.

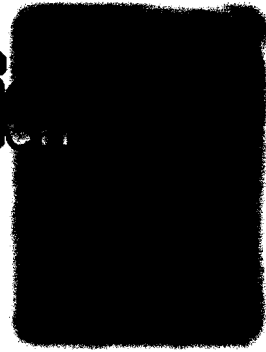
The Living Proog Group is planning their Annual Campout Under the Stars August 16-18, at Stillwater Campground, groupsite B.

## **URMRNA Alternate Delegate Report**

**June 1, 2013**

Hi Everyone,

I don't have a lot to add that wasn't included in Delynda's report, but I can expand on some of those points.

### **Traditions Book**

The Traditions Book Project is well underway, as you know, and the discussion board is up. If you have any comments on how you would like the book to look or things to be included, this would be a good place to start. It also is fun to go see what others are saying about it. On the same subject, a project page is available on na.org under projects and surveys. The powerpoint, session profile and all sheets that were in the workshop are available there if you are interested in workshopping it in your areas. Remember to send in the sheets to NAWs from your workshops so it can be included in the project. There is also an online questionnaire on the same page under projects.

### **Service System Project**

Also, under the Projects and Surveys tab is the Service System Project page. This is a great place to keep updated on changes and issues as well as workshop material if you are interested in workshopping this in your areas. Field testing is still going on in areas around the US and field test results will be produced in July. There is more research going on under the State, National, Province section of the SSP. The WB is contacting different regions that have multiple regions or split regions in their state to gather information, open discussions and possibly work on reunifying split regions.

### **WSC**

Right now there is a lot of discussion going on about the role of the AD and funding the RD to world, as Delynda mentioned. The cost of the 2012 WSC was \$473,719. The total cost in 2000 was \$121,734. Of the total for 2012 the cost to the WSC for Alternates to attend was \$165,570. A lot of discussion going on right now is how much benefit is it to have the AD attend and is it worth the cost. Some other concerns are the size of the conference and the seeming inequality of more US alternates vs. non-US alternates. Average AD attendance in the US is over 90% while non-US AD attendance is less than 50%. Also, I read somewhere, but of course can't find it now for the exact percentage, but only slightly over 50% of Alternates actually rotate into the Delegate position, which kind of shocked me.

As for World funding the RD travel to the WSC, the WB is looking into different ideas and where the intent of the original motion to fund was met and not met. Some options are: 1. Cost equalization where all communities pay the same dollar amount to attend the conference, sharing the burden. 2. Need based funding, not automatic funding, where a region would apply for support. And 3. Regions possibly 'adopting' another region in addition to paying their own way. Of course, going on as we have is also an option. More will be revealed.

### **WCNA-36**

World has the location set in Rio Centro in Brazil for 11-14 of June 2015.

### **RMZF - Casper**

I'm getting pretty excited to attend the zonal forum in July. Flyers have been e-mailed out are available to take back to your areas and groups. Anyone is welcome to attend and it's great that it is in our region this time.

### **Meeting lists/websites**

I recommend to all to read NAWS News, it is the best publication to keep informed of what is going on at the World level.

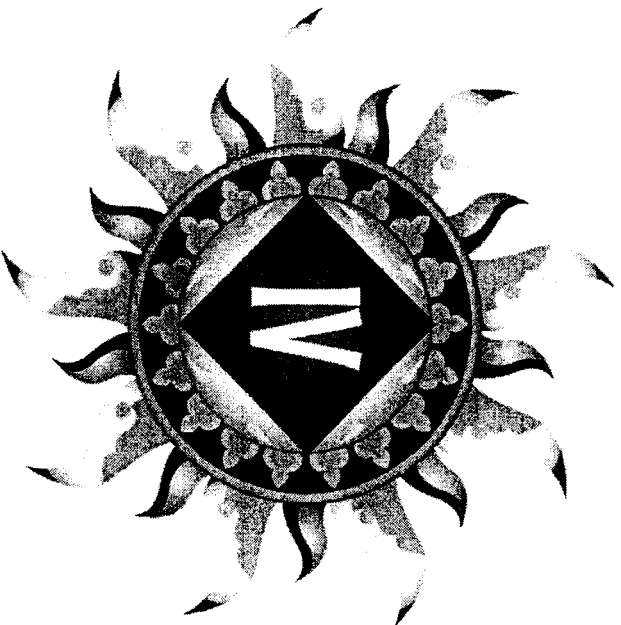

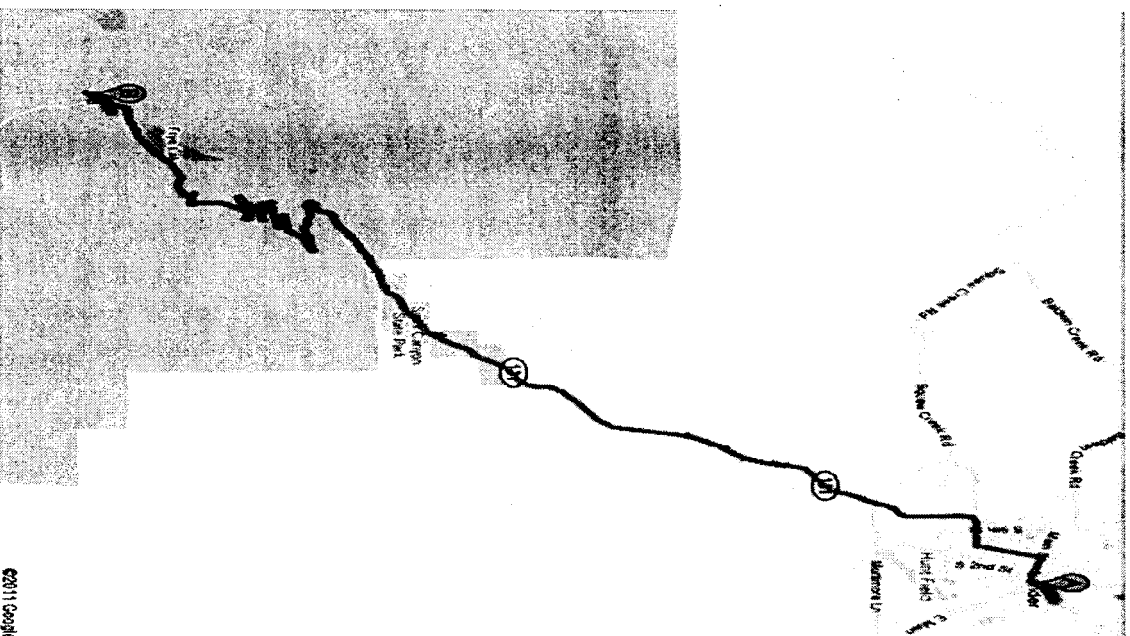
